Offering an international volume, Le Monografie serves the development of scientific knowledge, contributing to major debates by enhancing the quality and reliability of scientific information derived from archaeological research.

Anyone wishing to contribute may submit their article (minimum 20,000 characters - maximum 50,000 characters, including spaces) by 2nd June, 2024.

Please note that authors will **not** be compensated for their contributions.

Special Issue: Plinio il Vecchio (Pliny the Elder).

Each article should be accompanied by:

- An abstract in both the language of the article and English.
- Keywords (4) in both the language of the article and English.
- Brief bio-bibliography of the author (maximum 10 lines).

Please adhere to the Collection's editorial guidelines for text formatting. Proposals in a different format will not be considered.

All articles will undergo **blind peer review** by external reviewers.

Reviewers, vary for each edition, they will evaluate the article as: a) accepted, b) accepted with suggestions for improvement, c) not accepted.

Review results will be communicated to authors within a reasonable timeframe, allowing for text improvements in line with reviewers' suggestions.
